I have the honour to inform that DDT was only being used by the Ministry of Health of Mozambique for malaria prevention and other disease combat.

Therefore, DDT is prohibited for agriculture use in Mozambique and we agree with the ongoing initiative to ban it, since it is not part of the last pre-qualification carried out in August 2020 by the World Health Organization (WHO).
